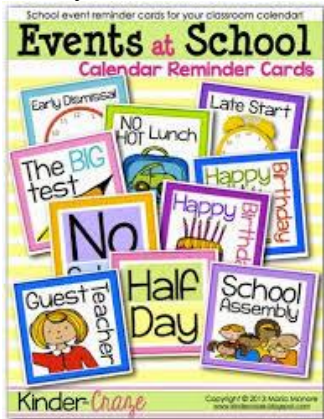


Responsibility start very early and it can be fun!

Teach your child responsibility by helping him/her get organized:

- Use a calendar at home to mark special dates. Go over it with your child so that you can share your excitement about upcoming school events.



- Sit with your child and check his/her school bag daily. Make sure you and your child go through the homework. Use “in” and “out” boxes. Teach your child to put homework assignments in the “in” box. After homework is completed and you have checked them, let him/her put them in the “out” box. When the “in” box is empty and the “out” box is full, then your child can put his/her completed homework in his/her schoolbag.



- Show your child the importance of schoolwork. Ask him/her to choose a piece of his/her work to display on your fridge on a weekly basis.
